Vosne-Romanée “Les Cinq Terres”

Plot

Vosne-Romanée is an appellation village of the Côte de Nuits. It was in 1866 that the village of Vosne added the name of its illustrious climate of "La Romanée" to its own name so that its notoriety would benefit all the wines of the town.

Our Vosne-Romanée is an assembly of five localities on both sides of the village of Vosne-Romanée: 'Aux Ormes', 'les Chalandains', 'Vigneux' north of Vosne-Romanée and 'Les Jacquines' and 'Les Raviolles' south of the village, near the combe de Nuits Saint Georges.

Vintage 2023

A late bloom of our vine which protected our buttons from frost in April. We had a dry and hot summer with no big impact thanks to the rain who showed up a few times during this time of the year.

Vinification and ageing

Fermentation with natural yeast in concrete vats.

Ageing of 18 months in french oak barrels , with 38% of new oak.

Tasting

The colour of the wine is ruby.

On the nose, red berries, wood, spices and leather.

On the palate, fresh, balance, structure and complex.

Service

To serve at 15°C

To pair with red meat, game meat, cheese

To keep 5 to 7 years
